Akawa Butte, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with spotting and torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Ten miles southeast of Walla Walla, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Horse Ridge, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing and creeping. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NR Team 2). One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, wind-driven runs and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and spotting. Communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Brewer, Prineville Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 3). Fifteen miles east of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hay Creek Complex (5 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing.

0579 Ten Mile, Prineville District, BLM. Nine miles northeast of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, backing and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with spotting, torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and flanking. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Henry, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NR Team 3). Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Powder River, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Fox incident. Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

* **Fox**, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Evacuations in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Stone Creek, Dairy, Well, Crater, Stubble, Bald Mountain, Second Flat and Jackass Butte incidents. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Stone Creek, Malheur NF, USFS. Ten miles south of Suplee, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened.

* **Dairy**, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northwest of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

* **Well**, Burns District, BLM. Sixteen miles northwest of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching.

* **Crater**, Burns District, BLM. Thirty-five miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

* **Stubble**, Malheur NWR, FWS. Fifteen miles southwest of Lawen, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

* **Bald Mountain**, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior. Numerous structures threatened.

* **Second Flat**, Burns District, BLM. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

* **Jackass Butte**, Burns District, BLM. Forty miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 1). CIMT (FL State Team 3) mobilizing. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area closures in effect.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). CIMT is also managing the Olive Butte incident. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and spotting. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2) mobilizing. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and running. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with spotting, running and torching. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Structures threatened.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with backing, short-range spotting and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Bench, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, wind-driven runs and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Beachcomb**, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and backing. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (GB Team 5) mobilizing. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, wind-driven runs and spotting. Structures threatened.

Railroad, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Nine miles north of Mattawa, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and running. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Locust Grove**, Benton County Fire Districts. Three miles south of Kennewick, WA. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and backing.

Crowley, Vale District, BLM. Thirty-two miles west of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, backing and smoldering. Structures threatened.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **0611 Green Mountain**, Ochoco NF, USFS. Eleven miles north of Prineville, OR. Timber and medium slash. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, uphill runs and long-range spotting. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

* **Signal Peak**, Yakama Agency, BIA. One mile south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and spotting. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

* **Hat**, Vale District, BLM. Forty miles east of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

* **Luna**, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and backing. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Widespread critical conditions will develop across the Inland Northwest into the northern Rockies and northwestern Great Basin today from westerly winds 15-30 mph with gusts 30-45 mph amid relative humidity of 5-15%. Elevated conditions from slightly weaker westerly winds are expected in central Idaho to southwest and central Montana, as well, where temperatures will be up to 20°F above normal. Very hot, record-setting temperatures 100-110°F are expected in southeast Montana into the western Dakotas with relative humidity below 20%, and isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will develop resulting in several new ignitions. Hot and dry conditions are expected in much of central and southern California, while isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms develop in central Nevada to southeast Idaho and northern Utah. Isolated wet monsoon thunderstorms are expected in the Southwest into the central Rockies.

Farther east, breezy conditions and low relative humidity and hot temperatures will support elevated fire weather conditions across the southern High Plains. In Minnesota, breezy northwest wind are expected amid hot temperatures and relative humidity of 25-40%. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop in the Great Lakes and Southeast, with scattered thunderstorms in Florida capable of new ignitions due to the ongoing long-term drought.
