On July 24th, a fourth firefighter, from the U.S. Wildland Fire Service, succumbed to injuries sustained while engaged in firefighting operations on the Knowles fire west of Grand Junction, CO on June 27th. The firefighting community extends its condolences to the family and friends of the deceased.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. One MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

**Akawa Butte**, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with spotting, torching and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Paradise**, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Ten miles southeast of Walla Walla, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Hagen**, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Horse Ridge**, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Rowe Creek Complex** (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and spotting. Communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Brewer**, Prineville Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 3). CIMT is also managing the 0611 Green Mountain incident. Fifteen miles east of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**0611 Green Mountain**, Ochoco NF, USFS. Eleven miles north of Prineville, OR. Timber and medium slash. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, spotting and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Kaiser Canyon**, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NR Team 2). One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, wind-driven runs and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

**Hay Creek Complex** (5 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Anthony**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Burnt Creek**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with spotting, torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Little Giant**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Dirty Face incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, crowning and long-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

\* **Dirty Face**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Thirty-eight miles northwest of Wenatchee, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

**Powder River**, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Fox incident. Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Fox**, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass and closed timber litter. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, running and long-range spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Coyote**, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Henry**, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and wind-driven runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Salmon**, Umatilla NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 12) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Olive Butte incident. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Olive Butte**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and spotting. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**E Evans Creek Rd**, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. Transfer of command from CIMT (ODF Team 1) to CIMT (FL State Team 3) will occur tomorrow. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Hat**, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 5) mobilizing. Forty miles east of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

**0587 Shingle**, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (GB Team 5) mobilizing. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and long-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

**Bench**, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. CIMT (SW Team 4) mobilizing. Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, long-range spotting and running. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Ptarmigan**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, crowning and spotting. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

**Big Grass**, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and running. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

**0579 Ten Mile**, Prineville District, BLM. Nine miles northeast of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Bologna**, Umatilla NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with backing, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

**Railroad**, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Nine miles north of Mattawa, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Beachcomb**, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, long-range spotting and running. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Border 2**, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Castle**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, torching and short-range spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Signal Peak**, Yakama Agency, BIA. One mile south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and spotting. Area and road closures in effect.

**Luna**, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

\* **Grasshopper**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Seven miles west of Wamic, OR. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with group torching, wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

\* **Bradeen Hill**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Grass, timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and flanking. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

\* **Bob Creek**, Vale District, BLM. Forty-eight miles northeast of Baker City, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

\* **Pearl Hill**, Spokane District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Bridgeport, WA. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with backing, running and flanking. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Egypt**, Malheur NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Second Flat, Jackass Butte, Stubble, Bald Mountain and Crater incidents. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. No new information.

**Second Flat**, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4) mobilizing. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, road and trail closures in effect.

**Stubble**, Malheur NWR, FWS. Fifteen miles southwest of Lawen, OR. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Jackass Butte**, Burns District, BLM. Forty miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Bald Mountain**, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Numerous structures threatened.

**Crater**, Burns District, BLM. Thirty-five miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

**Modrite**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NR Team 3). Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. No new information.

**Stone Creek**, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. No new information.

**Dairy**, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northwest of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. No new information.

**Well**, Burns District, BLM. Sixteen miles northwest of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. No new information.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Widespread elevated to critical conditions will develop again today across the Inland Northwest into the northern Rockies and northwestern Great Basin today from westerly winds 15-25 mph with gusts 25-35 mph amid relative humidity of 5-20%. These breezy and dry conditions will spread into the central Great Basin later today, as well. Hot temperatures near 100°F will continue in much of the Great Basin, central Rockies, and northern Rockies east of the Divide with low afternoon humidity. Isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will develop across southern Montana and Wyoming this afternoon capable of several new ignitions. Hot and dry conditions are expected in much of central and southern California, while isolated wet monsoon thunderstorms are expected in the Southwest, with mixed wet and dry thunderstorms in Colorado.

Farther east, breezy conditions and low relative humidity and hot temperatures will support elevated fire weather conditions across the southern High Plains as relative humidity falls as low as 15%. In Minnesota, breezy southerly winds will develop but relative humidity is higher near 40%, with isolated to scattered wet thunderstorms developing overnight. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop in the Great Lakes to the Southeast, with scattered to numerous wet thunderstorms in Florida likely to temporarily ease conditions there.
