One 15-member incident management team and 59 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. One MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Coleman Creek incident. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. One mile east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bench, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. CIMT (SW Team 4). Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Hagen and Horse Ridge incidents. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Horse Ridge, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Dirty Face incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, crowning and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dirty Face, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Thirty-eight miles northwest of Wenatchee, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Powder River, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Fox incident. Four miles southwest of Richland, OR. Grass, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Evacuations in effect.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, running and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 2) and CIMT (ODF Team 3). Includes the acreage from the previously reported Brewer incident. Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, timber and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, torching and spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (GB Team 5). Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with torching, backing and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Burnt Creek incident. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with spotting, isolated torching and running. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NR Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Bradeen Hill incident. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and group torching. Area and road closures in effect.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Numerous residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (NR Team 2). One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Hat, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Big Grass incident. Forty miles east of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, creeping and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, wind-driven runs and running. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Jackass Butte, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (SA Team 2). CIMT is also managing the Bald Mountain, Stubble and Crater incidents. Forty miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and flanking. Numerous structures threatened.

Stubble, Malheur NWR, FWS. Fifteen miles southwest of Lawen, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and flanking. Structures threatened.

Crater, Burns District, BLM. Thirty-five miles south of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Akawa Butte, Sisters Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (ODF Team 2). Thirteen miles northeast of Sisters, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, flanking and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Henry incident. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Henry, Prineville District, BLM. Five miles south of Paulina Guard Station, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hay Creek Complex, Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Five miles west of Condon, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (FL State Team 3). Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 6). Three miles north of Sportsman Park, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with group torching, wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 3). Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with backing, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Twelve miles west of Tonasket, WA. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Skyyo**, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Three miles southwest of Packwood, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Olive Butte, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bob Creek, Vale District, BLM. One mile north of Oxbow, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with isolated torching, flanking and backing. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

Signal Peak, Yakama Agency, BIA. One mile south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and wind-driven runs. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, backing and flanking. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Pearl Hill, Spokane District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Bridgeport, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Ransier, Yakama Agency, BIA. Two miles south of White Swan, WA. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area closures in effect.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

0579 Ten Mile, Prineville District, BLM. Nine miles northeast of Madras, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated dry thunderstorms may be ongoing this morning across southern Idaho, with isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms expected this afternoon from Utah into much of Wyoming and portions of Montana with some new ignitions possible. No thunderstorms are expected in the Northwest amid minimum RH of 10-20% except for a very slight chance of a thunderstorm in the Blue Mountains. Isolated to scattered wet monsoon thunderstorms continue in the Southwest and Colorado. Temperatures near to slightly below normal will be common in the Northwest, while hot temperatures (85-100°F) are expected across eastern Montana northeast Wyoming, the Dakotas to Minnesota while very hot temperatures (95-110°F) continue in the southern Plains. Slight cooling is expected in the Lower Mississippi Valley due to a weak cold front that will result in isolated thunderstorms and possibly a few new ignitions. Temperatures will trend 5-15°F above normal Southwest as the monsoon weakens, with similar above normal temperatures in most of California and the Great Basin and low afternoon RH. Farther east, cooler conditions along much of the East Coast. Scattered thunderstorms in South Georgia and Florida which will continue to bring temporary relief. High-risk significant fire potential for burn environment in portions of north Texas and western Oklahoma amid persistently very hot temperatures. Increased winds are expected near the Hawai'i as Tropical Storm Fausto passes to the north of the islands.
