\* **Kartar**, Colville Agency, BIA. Fifteen miles southeast of Omak, WA. Grass, timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

\* **Roza**, Spokane District, BLM. Nine miles north of Selah, WA. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened.

\* **Cable Creek**, Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. Eight miles east of Ukiah, OR. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running and wind-driven runs. Structures threatened.

**Tule Rd**, Yakama Agency, BIA. CIMT (NW Team 2). Five miles south of Toppenish, WA. Grass, brush and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Upriver**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land one mile east of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

\* **Tucannon Mutual Aid**, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Eight miles east of Dayton, WA. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Old Emigrant**, Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. Six miles southeast of Pendleton, OR. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Juniper Dunes**, Spokane District, BLM. Ten miles northeast of Pasco, WA. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Hot and dry conditions will persist across the western third of the US today with more triple digit heat and single digit relative humidity across the Desert Southwest. Additionally expect locally breezy conditions in the afternoon and evening, especially over southern Utah and southern Nevada. More thunderstorms are also anticipated over the northern Sierra and southeast Arizona, southern New Mexico and west Texas during the afternoon and evening. These storms will produce spotty rainfall. Over the remainder of the Lower 48 states, most locations will experience cool and wet weather. The exception will occur along the Eastern Seaboard where temperatures will reach the 90s with relative humidity values below 40% before a cold front pushes through in the afternoon. Over Alaska expect drying conditions with warming temperatures, especially over the interior.
