Cottonwood, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Five miles east of Beaver, UT. Timber, brush and light slash. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, uphill runs and long-range spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Iron, Central Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 3). One mile northwest of Eureka, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

Grapevine, Ely District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Caliente, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Structures threatened.

Kinky Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles northwest of Cora, WY. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs and short-range spotting. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect.

Kane Springs, Ely District, BLM. Seventeen miles southwest of Caliente, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Railroad infrastructure threatened.

Hastings, West Desert District, BLM. Thirty-five miles northwest of Dugway, UT. Chaparral. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Sawmill, Color Country Paria Unit, BLM. Forty-four miles northwest of Cedar City, UT. Dormant brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened.

Rock Canyon, Northern District, Arizona DOF. Twenty miles southeast of Fredonia, AZ. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Pocket, Coconino NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 2). Seven miles north of Sedona, AZ. Timber and chaparral. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, torching and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

* **McCauley Springs**, Santa Fe NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 3). Four miles northeast of Jemez Springs, NM. Timber, medium slash and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and flanking. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Sycamore, Tonto NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Globe, AZ. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Canyon Venado, Bernalillo District, NM State Forestry. Five miles east of Clines Corner, NM. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with group torching. Energy infrastructure threatened.

White Tail, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Twelve miles northeast of San Carlos, AZ. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Elliott Complex, Tanana Zone, BLM. Started on Alaska Native Corporation land 11 miles northwest of Minto, AK. Timber, brush and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

* **Polly**, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Started on state land 21 miles northeast of Chicken, AK. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A significant pattern change will take shape across the West today, with extremely critical fire weather quickly developing in areas that picked up abundant lightning the last day or two. Relative humidity as low as 3-10% and southwesterly wind gusts from 30-50 mph will be common in the lee of the southern Sierra through much of southern Nevada, northwestern Arizona and Utah. Lightning holdovers are likely to emerge, and established fires may see explosive, wind-driven growth. Hot temperatures will prevail in these areas, but much cooler air will overspread the northern Intermountain West behind a cold front that will bring a problematic wind shift to portions of the Great Basin late in the day. While it will be windy across the rest of California and along the Sierra Front, humidity will be less critical than farther south or east. Scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms will continue from eastern Arizona into New Mexico and portions of the West Slope, potentially contributing to additional new fire starts and gusty outflow winds. Showers and Pacific moisture will bring moderating conditions from the Northwest to the northern Rockies. Look for hot, dry and breezy conditions in the Mid-Atlantic states, while sea breezes will kick off scattered thunderstorms in the coastal Southeast. Alaska will continue to see widely scattered thunderstorms, with the driest and warmest conditions persisting in the northwestern Interior.
