Cottonwood, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Five miles east of Beaver, UT. Timber, brush and light slash. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, running and long-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Iron, Central Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 3). One mile northwest of Eureka, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with wind-driven runs, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

Grapevine, Ely District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Caliente, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and group torching. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Kinky Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles northwest of Cora, WY. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with group torching and short-range spotting. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect.

Kane Springs, Ely District, BLM. Seventeen miles southwest of Caliente, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

* **Wild Goose**, Fishlake NF, USFS. Twelve miles northeast of Fillmore, UT. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with running, short-range spotting and flanking. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened.

* **Cherry**, West Desert District, BLM. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Santaquin, UT. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with torching, running and flanking. Residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

* **Maple Peak**, West Desert District, BLM. Twenty-seven miles southwest of Santaquin, UT. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

* **Babylon**, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southwest of Monticello, UT. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching, spotting and creeping. Residences threatened.

* **Dry Canyon**, Ely District, BLM. Fourteen miles east of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, wind-driven runs and long-range spotting.

* **Parsnip Peak**, Ely District, BLM. Eighteen miles northwest of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, crowning and short-range spotting.

Hastings, West Desert District, BLM. Thirty-five miles northwest of Dugway, UT. Chaparral. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Sawmill, Color Country Paria Unit, BLM. Forty-four miles northwest of Cedar City, UT. Dormant brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

McCauley Springs, Santa Fe NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 3). Four miles northeast of Jemez Springs, NM. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Sycamore, Tonto NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Globe, AZ. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and single tree torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Canyon Venado, Bernalillo District, NM State Forestry. Five miles east of Clines Corner, NM. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened.

White Tail, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Twelve miles northeast of San Carlos, AZ. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Flat, Fort Apache Agency, BIA. Nine miles southwest of Heber, AZ. Medium slash, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Predictive Services Discussion:

The southern Intermountain West will continue to be plagued by dry and unusually windy conditions today. Extremely critical fire weather, with southwesterly winds gusting from 30-60 mph, locally stronger in favored downslope areas, along with relative humidity from 5-15% will be most likely across northern Arizona into eastern Utah, western Colorado and far northwestern New Mexico. These conditions are extraordinarily rare for late June, and impacts will likely be severe. Widespread elevated to critical conditions will otherwise persist from Nevada and the deserts of southern California into the greater Four Corners and far southern Wyoming. Well below average temperatures for the end of June will be the rule farther west and north, with widespread rain showers, embedded thunderstorms and even some mountain snow across the northern Intermountain West. Hot and unstable conditions with scattered afternoon thunderstorms will continue for the coastal Southeast, while some flash flooding is possible in the Tennessee Valley. Expect scattered thunderstorms over central and eastern Interior Alaska, with some hot and dry conditions continuing from the northwestern Interior to the Yukon Flats.
