**Cottonwood**, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Five miles east of Beaver, UT. Timber, brush and light slash. Extreme fire behavior with uphill runs, running and long-range spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Wild Goose**, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 7). Twelve miles northeast of Fillmore, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

**Iron**, Central Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cherry incident. One mile northwest of Eureka, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Cherry**, West Desert District, BLM. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Santaquin, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, running and group torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Grapevine**, Ely District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Caliente, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

**Parsnip Peak**, Ely District, BLM. Eighteen miles northwest of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, crowning and short-range spotting.

**Dry Canyon**, Ely District, BLM. Fourteen miles east of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and long-range spotting.

**Babylon**, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southwest of Monticello, UT. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching, spotting and creeping. Structures threatened.

**Kinky Creek**, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles northwest of Cora, WY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Kane Springs**, Ely District, BLM. Seventeen miles southwest of Caliente, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

\* **Snyder**, Desert Rivers Fire and Aviation Management Unit, BLM. CIMT (RM Team 1) mobilizing. Thirteen miles west of Grand Junction, CO. Timber and chaparral. Active fire behavior with running, torching and spotting. Evacuations in effect.

**Sawmill**, Color Country Paria Unit, BLM. Forty-four miles northwest of Cedar City, UT. Dormant brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

The southern Intermountain West will continue to see dry and very windy conditions today as the pattern across the West will be slow to change. With poor moisture recovery and another day of rapid drying, fire activity is likely to remain significant for the southern Great Basin, Southwest and Rocky Mountain geographic areas. Lightning holdovers may continue to emerge. Look for relative humidity from 8-15% across the region, with southwesterly winds gusting from 25-50 mph, locally higher in favored downslope terrain. Any extremely critical conditions will be more localized than on Saturday. The northern Intermountain West will be unseasonably chilly, with record cold high temperatures and some heavy snow in the higher elevations of Idaho, Montana and far northwestern Wyoming. Meanwhile, very hot, dry and breezy conditions will expand across the central and southern High Plains. Alaska will be cool and rainy, with minimal lightning and lower impacts to ongoing fires. Hot and drier conditions followed by isolated afternoon thunderstorms will bring increasing fire risks to the Florida peninsula and portions of the coastal Carolinas.
