Cottonwood, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Five miles east of Beaver, UT. Timber, brush and light slash. Active fire behavior with torching, short-range spotting and short crown runs. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wild Goose, Fishlake NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 7). Twelve miles northeast of Fillmore, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Iron, Central Area, Utah DOF. CIMT (GB Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cherry incident. One mile northwest of Eureka, UT. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Road closures in effect.

Cherry, West Desert District, BLM. Twenty-nine miles southwest of Santaquin, UT. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Babylon, Manti-La Sal NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2) mobilizing. Twenty-five miles southwest of Monticello, UT. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching, spotting and creeping. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grapevine, Ely District, BLM. Ten miles southeast of Caliente, NV. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Parsnip Peak, Ely District, BLM. Eighteen miles northwest of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, creeping and smoldering.

Horse Head, Desert Rivers Fire and Aviation Management Unit, BLM. Seven miles southwest of Eastland, UT. Dormant brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, running and wind-driven runs. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Dry Canyon, Ely District, BLM. Fourteen miles east of Pioche, NV. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Kinky Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles northwest of Cora, WY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Snyder, Desert Rivers Fire and Aviation Management Unit, BLM. CIMT (RM Team 1). Thirteen miles west of Grand Junction, CO. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Kane Springs, Ely District, BLM. Seventeen miles southwest of Caliente, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Sawmill, Color Country Paria Unit, BLM. Forty-four miles northwest of Cedar City, UT. Dormant brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened.

Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and group torching. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

* **Aspen Acres**, Custer County. CIMT (AK Team 1) mobilizing. Ten miles northwest of Rye, CO. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Willow, Pike and San Isabel NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 4). Ten miles west of Leadville, CO. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, spotting and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ferris, San Juan NF, USFS. Seven miles east of Cahone, CO. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and short-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red Rock, Grand Junction Field Office, BLM. Twelve miles west of De Beque, CO. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior. Energy infrastructure threatened. Road closures in effect.

* **Rocky Ridge**, Goshen County. Sixteen miles south of Lusk, WY. Grass. Active fire behavior with running.

Doe Canyon, San Juan NF, USFS. Seven miles east of Cahone, CO. Grass, timber and brush. No new information.

McCauley Springs, Santa Fe NF, USFS. CIMT (SW Team 3). Four miles northeast of Jemez Springs, NM. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Beehive, Carson NF, USFS. Fifteen miles northeast of Tres Piedras, NM. Timber. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, short-range spotting and flanking.

* **Sacaton**, Gila NF, USFS. Fifteen miles east of Glenwood, NM. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with group torching, long-range spotting and flanking. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Sycamore, Tonto NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Globe, AZ. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Butte, Kaibab NF, USFS. Eleven miles south of Tusayan, AZ. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures threatened.

White Tail, San Carlos Agency, BIA. Twelve miles northeast of San Carlos, AZ. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior.

Canyon Venado, Bernalillo District, NM State Forestry. Five miles east of Clines Corner, NM. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened.

Steamboat, Gila District, BLM. One mile south of Dripping Springs, AZ. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.
