Qury, South Dakota Division of Wildland Fire. Two miles southeast of Custer, SD. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coyote Flats, Black Hills NF, USFS. Two miles east of Rockerville, SD. Grass and timber. Active fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

Morrill, Nebraska Forest Service. CIMT (RM Team 1). Fifteen miles northeast of Bridgeport, NE. Timber, grass and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Cottonwood, Nebraska Forest Service. Five miles southwest of Brady, NE. Grass, timber and dormant brush. Moderate fire behavior with short crown runs, flanking and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Quail Road**, Morris County. Six miles southwest of Marysville, KS. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior. Structures and railroad infrastructure threatened.

* **Kane**, Bighorn Canyon National Recreation Area, NPS. Six miles east of Lovell, WY. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running and flanking. Residences threatened.

Road 203, Nebraska NF, USFS. Eight miles southwest of Halsey, NE. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

* **Cross Timber**, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northeast of Asher, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs.

* **Mill Pond**, National Forests in Florida, USFS. Three miles south of Telogia, FL. Southern rough and grass. Active fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

* **Bondarenko Ct**, Florida Forest Service. Two miles south of Belmore, FL. Southern rough and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, short-range spotting and running.

* **Soapstone**, North Carolina Forest Service. Ten miles southwest of Wilkesboro, NC. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking. Structures threatened.

* **Sunshine Hollow S**, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northwest of Finley, OK. Hardwood litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with wind-driven runs. Residences threatened.

* **Nickle**, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles west of Watts, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior. Structures threatened.

* **Burgess East**, National Forests in Alabama, USFS. Ten miles southeast of Talladega, AL. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and backing.

* **Lovers Leap**, Osage Agency, BIA. One mile northwest of Pawhuska, OK. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering.

* **Sunshine Hollow**, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northwest of Finely, OK. Hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing. Structures threatened.

* **Burris Valley**, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles north of Daisy, OK. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing.

* **Powerline**, Oklahoma DOF. Nine miles west of Stilwell, OK. Hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior.

139, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile north of Wilma, FL. Southern rough. Extreme fire behavior with torching, running and flanking.

Rattlesnake Hollow, Okmulgee Agency, BIA. Six miles north of Hanna, OK. Hardwood litter, grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Turkey Scratch, Florida Forest Service. Five miles southwest of Aucilla, FL. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Trail closures in effect.

Sunset, Louisiana Office of Forestry. Five miles north of Winnfield, LA. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Boy Scout, Osage Agency, BIA. Two miles west of Okesa, OK. Grass, timber and dormant brush. No new information.

Cumulative acres shown in the Active Incident Resource Summary Table may not be reflected in the YTD statistics due to a lag in units completing YTD adjustments in the SIT/209 Application. Otherwise, changes in agency YTD fires and acres reflect more accurate mapping or reporting adjustments.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A dry cold front will move through the Southeast today, with dry northwest winds behind the front across the Appalachians to the coast. Winds 12-25 mph with gusts to 30 mph amid relative humidity of 20-30% will create elevated to critical conditions in this area. Dry and breezy southerly return flow winds will develop over the central Plains today, creating localized elevated conditions. Hot, well above normal temperatures will continue in the Southwest amid very low relative humidity of 3-12% and poor overnight recovery, with above normal temperatures returning to the northern half of the West after yesterday's brief cooldown. Below normal temperatures and dry conditions will continue over much of Alaska, while drier air returns to the western Hawai'ian Islands but heavy showers remain possible for the eastern islands.
