* **Luna Branch**, Oklahoma DOF. Seventeen miles northeast of Tahlequah, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Active fire behavior. Structures threatened.

* **90 Degrees**, Oklahoma DOF. Eight miles north of Wilburton, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

* **South Sandy**, National Forests in Alabama, USFS. Four miles southwest of Duncanville, AL. Timber, brush and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, single tree torching and smoldering. Structures threatened.

* **Polk Treat Mountain**, Georgia Forestry Commission. Two miles south of Esom Hill, GA. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

* **Rattlesnake Cliff**, Kentucky DOF. Started on private land nine miles north of Monticello, KY. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs and short-range spotting.

* **Barbed Wire**, Oklahoma DOF. Ten miles north of Sallisaw, OK. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior.

* **Oxbow**, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northeast of Boley, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, single tree torching and flanking.

* **Sonny Gile**, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northwest of Nicut, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs and wind-driven runs.

* **Old Kentucky**, Oklahoma DOF. Eleven miles north of Sallisaw, OK. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior.

* **Pumpkin Hollow**, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles northwest of Proctor, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs.

* **Tarkiln Ridge**, National Forests in North Carolina, USFS. Five miles northwest of Hayesville, NC. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior.

* **Saltsman**, Okmulgee Agency, BIA. Five miles east of Hannah, OK. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking.

* **Middle Creek**, Okmulgee Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Hannah, OK. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing and creeping.

Baker Rd, Florida Forest Service. Ten miles northeast of Fountain, FL. Southern rough and grass. Moderate fire behavior with running, long-range spotting and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened.

Mill Pond, National Forests in Florida, USFS. Three miles south of Telogia, FL. Southern rough and grass. Active fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

139, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile north of Wilma, FL. Southern rough. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and torching.

Cross Timber, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northeast of Asher, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and single tree torching. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Sunshine Hollow S, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northwest of Finley, OK. Hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping. Residences threatened.

Sunshine Hollow, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northwest of Finley, OK. Hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened.

Woodlawn, Francis Marion & Sumter NF, USFS. Six miles north of Evans, SC. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and backing.

Sand Creek, Osage Agency, BIA. Six miles northeast of Hominy, OK. Grass, dormant brush and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping.

Pine Tree, Oklahoma DOF. Seven miles southwest of Antlers, OK. Timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping.

Jumping Juniper, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles south of Vici, OK. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

4DS, Osage Agency, BIA. Four miles northeast of Barnsdall, OK. Timber, hardwood litter and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing and creeping.

Boy Scout, Osage Agency, BIA. Two miles west of Okesa, OK. Grass, timber and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing and creeping. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Burriss Valley, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles north of Daisy, OK. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Burgess East, National Forests in Alabama, USFS. Ten miles southeast of Talladega, AL. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Lovers Leap, Osage Agency, BIA. One mile northwest of Pawhuska, OK. Hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Road 203, Nebraska NF, USFS. Eight miles southwest of Halsey, NE. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Hot, well above normal, and in some cases, record-setting temperatures will continue today across much of the West, with the greatest warm anomalies in the Great Basins and central Rockies. Very low relative humidity of 5-18% will occur this afternoon, as well, with poor overnight recovery. Breezy westerly winds 15-25 mph will also occur from eastern Oregon into the northern Great Basin and Wyoming, creating localized elevated conditions. However, much of Washington and coastal Oregon will be near normal today due to increased cloud cover, with wetting precipitation expected, albeit with high snow levels. Very dry conditions are expected in much of the Lower Mississippi Valley to the Southeast as relative humidity falls to 15-30% in the afternoon, but winds will be lighter today. Isolated thunderstorms will develop in northeast Florida with localized wetting rain along a stalled front. Cold, below normal temperatures will continue over much of Alaska, while drier northeast trade winds return to much of Hawai'i today with occasional windward showers.
