* **Hutchinson**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land nine miles northwest of Borger, TX. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, wind-driven runs and spotting.

* **Iron Post**, Oklahoma DOF. Five miles southeast of Locust Grove, OK. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior. Structures threatened.

* **Starwood Lane**, Oklahoma DOF. Eight miles west of Atoka, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with running and backing. Structures threatened.

* **Coleman Rd**, Georgia Forestry Commission. Three miles northeast of Fort Gaines, GA. Timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with short-range spotting and uphill runs. Structures threatened.

* **East Wind**, Oklahoma DOF. Eight miles north of Wilburton, OK. Hardwood litter and southern rough. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Residences threatened.

* **South Frazier Creek**, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles north of Sobol, OK. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with running and spotting. Residences threatened.

* **Hancock**, Florida Forest Service. Twenty-one miles northeast of Lake City, FL. Closed timber litter and southern rough. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing.

Tarkiln Ridge, National Forests in North Carolina, USFS. Five miles northwest of Hayesville, NC. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior.

Polk Treat Mountain, Georgia Forestry Commission. Two miles south of Esom Hill, GA. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Structures threatened.

Middle Creek, Okmulgee Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Hannah, OK. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, backing, and creeping. Structures threatened. Reduction in acres due to more accurate mapping.

Sonny Gille, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northwest of Nicut, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with running.

Old Kentucky, Oklahoma DOF. Eleven miles north of Sallisaw, OK. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior.

* **Twin Creek**, Alabama Forestry Commission. Twenty-one miles east of Grady, AL. Brush. Minimal fire behavior.

South Sandy, National Forests in Alabama, USFS. Four miles southwest of Duncanville, AL. Timber, brush and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, backing and creeping.

Oxbow, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles northeast of Boley, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with single tree torching and smoldering.

Mill Pond, National Forests in Florida, USFS. Three miles south of Telogia, FL. Southern rough and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

139, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile north of Wilma, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Woodlawn, Francis Marion & Sumpter NF, USFS. Six miles north of Evans, SC. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Jumping Juniper, Oklahoma DOF. Three miles south of Vici, OK. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with single tree torching and smoldering.

Powerline, Oklahoma DOF. Nine miles west of Stilwell, OK. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior.

Nickle, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles west of Watts, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Minimal fire behavior.

Baker Rd, Florida Forest Service. Ten miles northeast of Fountain, FL. Southern rough and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

* **Fenco Farms**, Florida Forest Service. Thirteen miles north of Crystal Rivet, FL. Medium slash and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Cross Timber, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northeast of Asher, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with single tree torching and smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Saltsman, Okmulgee Agency, BIA. Five miles east of Hannah, OK. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Rattlesnake Cliff, Kentucky DOF. Started on private land nine miles north of Monticello, KY. Timber and hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Luna Branch, Oklahoma DOF. Seventeen miles northeast of Tahlequah, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. No new information.

90 Degrees, Oklahoma DOF. Eight miles north of Wilburton, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. No new information.

Barbed Wire, Oklahoma DOF. Ten miles north of Sallisaw, OK. Hardwood litter. No new information.

Pumpkin Hollow, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles northwest of Proctor, OK. Timber. No new information.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Hot, well above normal, record-setting temperatures will continue today across much of the Great Basin and Southeast into the central and southern Plains. Very low relative humidity of 5-18% will occur this afternoon, as well, with poor overnight recovery, although humidity will be above 20% on the eastern portions of the Plains. Strong westerly winds of 15-35 mph with gusts 35-55 mph will develop across Montana into Wyoming and much of Nebraska, with elevated to critical conditions most likely from southern Montana through Wyoming into Nebraska and northern Colorado where relative humidity falls below 20%. Breezy southwest winds will also create areas of elevated conditions in the Texas panhandle. A cold front will move through the Northwest, northern Idaho, and northwest Montana bringing light precipitation and cooler temperatures. However, isolated dry thunderstorms are expected to develop near the Colorado/Wyoming border into the Nebraska panhandle tonight. Very dry conditions will continue in the southern Appalachians and Piedmont today, with increasing southwesterly winds of 10-18 mph in the afternoon creating locally elevated conditions. Below normal temperatures and mainly dry conditions will continue across most of Alaska, with breezy and dry trade winds across Hawai'i.
