Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy southwesterly winds 15-20 mph with gusts 25 to 35 mph amid relative humidity of 17-30% will develop ahead of a cold front across the Mid-Atlantic today creating areas of elevated conditions. Breezy westerly winds 10-20 mph will continue in the Great Lakes behind the front but relative humidity is expected to increase to near or above 30% keeping elevated conditions localized. Scattered to widespread showers and thunderstorms will develop along the front from the Mid-Mississippi Valley into northern New England, with more isolated thunderstorms into eastern Oklahoma and Texas. Very warm temperatures will continue across the Northwest and northern Rockies and minimum relative humidity below 25% but winds will be light. An upper-level low will move through the southern half of the West with scattered showers and thunderstorms, with more widespread precipitation for the Front Range, falling as snow above 7,000 feet. Near to below normal temperatures are expected across Alaska with a few showers across southwest and south-central Alaska. Trade winds will weaken today with sea breezes developing across Hawai'i, along with isolated to scattered showers.
