HWY 82, Georgia Forestry Commission. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 1) back to the local unit will occur today. Started on private land one mile east of Atkinson, GA. Southern rough, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Pineland Rd, Georgia Forestry Commission. Started on private land 13 miles northwest of Fargo, GA. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with backing, flanking and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

South Canal, Florida Forest Service. Twelve miles south of Mayo, FL. Southern rough and timber. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, long-range spotting and torching.

Lochloosa West, Florida Forest Service. Twelve miles southeast of Gainesville, FL. Timber and southern rough. Active fire behavior with running, long-range spotting and group torching.

Sargent, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile south of Sargent, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Railroad infrastructure threatened.

Cow Creek, Florida Forest Service. Ten miles south of Bronson, FL. Timber and southern rough. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Pelham 2, North Carolina Forest Service. Two miles northwest of Watha, NC. Medium slash. Active fire behavior with creeping.

N Main St 2, Florida Forest Service. Two miles west of Gainesville, FL. Timber and southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Rosindale Road, North Carolina Forest Service. Eight miles north of Lake Waccamaw, NC. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Hog Farm, Oklahoma DOF. Twenty-two miles southeast of Woodward, OK. Grass and hardwood litter. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.
