Pineland Rd, Georgia Forestry Commission. Started on private land 13 miles northwest of Fargo, GA. Southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

South Canal, Florida Forest Service. Twelve miles south of Mayo, FL. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Lochloosa West, Florida Forest Service. Twelve miles southeast of Gainesville, FL. Timber and southern rough. Moderate fire behavior with running, long-range spotting and short-range spotting.

Cow Creek, Florida Forest Service. Started on private land 10 miles south of Bronson, FL. Timber and southern rough. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Pelham 2, North Carolina Forest Service. Two miles northwest of Watha, NC. Medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

N Main St 2, Florida Forest Service. Started on private land two miles west of Gainesville, FL. Timber and southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Sargent, National Forests in Florida, USFS. One mile south of Sargent, FL. Southern rough. No new information.
