## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Very strong west winds 30-45 mph with gusts up to 70 mph will occur across Montana and Wyoming near and east of the Continental Divide into the western Dakotas today, amid relative humidity of 10-30%, lowest in southern Montana, Wyoming, and western South Dakota. Widespread elevated to critical conditions are expected as a result. Breezy south and west winds are expected ahead of and behind a cold front, respectively, across the eastern Dakotas, Minnesota, and Iowa amid relative humidity below 30% creating areas of elevated conditions. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are expected along the front, as well, but any rainfall will be light. Breezy and dry west winds 10-25 mph with gusts 35-35 mph amid relative humidity of 5-15% will develop across the Greater Four Corners into the southern High Plains. Dry conditions will persist across California and Nevada, while scattered showers are expected in western Washington. Widespread wetting rain is expected across New England, while drier conditions develop across much of the Southeast behind a cold front. Mild and dry conditions are expected across the Alaska Interior today, while isolated showers develop over south-central Alaska and the Alaska Range.
