Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, wind-driven runs and long-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Six Mile, Cibola NF, USFS. Twelve miles southeast of Magdalena, NM. Brush and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hummingbird, Gila NF, USFS. Fifteen miles east of Glenwood, NM. Timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Area closures in effect.
