Cow Creek, Florida Forest Service. Ten miles south of Bronson, FL. Timber and southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

* **Kress**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land 13 miles north of Plainview, TX. Grass. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and flanking.

Sharpe, Oklahoma DOF. Fourteen miles northwest of Boise City, OK. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Cumulative acres shown in the Active Incident Resource Summary Table may not be reflected in the YTD statistics due to a lag in units completing YTD adjustments in the SIT/209 Application. Otherwise, changes in agency YTD fires and acres reflect more accurate mapping or reporting adjustments.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Well above normal temperatures exceeding 90°F will continue in the Southeast and Mid-Atlantic along with low afternoon relative humidity below 30% this afternoon. Winds overall will be light except for locally breezy southwest winds in the Piedmont may create areas of elevated conditions. Much higher relative humidity is expected across the southern Plains today, stretching west to the High Plains where it will remain above 20% easing conditions from the past few days. Widespread showers and thunderstorms are expected with the higher humidity across South and East Texas into the Lower Mississippi Valley, with scattered showers and thunderstorms northeast into the Ohio Valley. Southwest winds 12-20 mph with gusts to 30 mph amid relative humidity of 7-15% will develop across eastern Arizona into central New Mexico creating elevated to locally critical conditions. Very dry conditions will persist in California today with humidity falling to 5-15% in the lower elevations, but winds will be much lighter and generally less than 10 mph. Near to slightly below normal temperatures will continue across Alaska today with isolated to scattered showers.
