Sandy, Ventura County Fire Department. One mile south of Simi Valley, CA. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, wind-driven runs and running. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Bain**, Riverside Unit, Cal Fire. One mile south of Jurupa Valley, CA. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Santa Rosa Island, Channel Islands National Park, NPS. Thirty-three miles southwest of Santa Barbara, CA. Brush, grass and chaparral. Active fire behavior with running, crowning and torching. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

River, Kern County Fire Department. Fifteen miles northeast of Bakersfield, CA. Grass. Minimal fire behavior.

Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Black Mesa Trail, Cimarron District, NM State Forestry. Previously reported incident. Thirty-two miles north of Clayton, NM. Brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Hummingbird, Gila NF, USFS. Fifteen miles east of Glenwood, NM. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Mimms, Las Vegas District, NM State Forestry. Five miles north of House, NM. Grass, brush and chaparral. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

* **Rifle Range Rd**, Florida Forest Service. Seven miles east of Naples, FL. Southern rough and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, running and torching.

Sharpe, Oklahoma DOF. Fourteen miles northwest of Boise City, OK. Grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Cow Creek, Florida Forest Service. Ten miles south of Bronson, FL. Timber and southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Lochloosa West, Florida Forest Service. Seven miles southwest of Hawthorne, FL. Timber and southern rough. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Kress, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land 13 miles north of Plainview, TX. Grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Last report unless significant activity occurs.
