Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Santa Maria, CA. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

**McConnell**, Winnemucca District, BLM. CIMT (GB Team 6). Three miles east of Orovada, NV. Grass, dormant brush and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and uphill runs. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Crooked**, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Blue Eagle**, Carson City District, BLM. Twenty-eight miles northwest of Austin, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, isolated torching and creeping. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

**Calico**, Humboldt-Toiyabe NF, USFS. Twenty miles southeast of McDermitt, NV. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and isolated torching. Residences threatened.

**Flint**, Boise District, BLM. Forty-five miles southwest of Nampa, ID. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Residences threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

**Slough Canyon**, Uintah and Ouray Agency, BIA. Forty-one miles east of Price, UT. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

**Doublesprings**, Salmon-Challis NF, USFS. Thirty-one miles northwest of Mackay, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

**Tom Creek**, West Desert District, BLM. Ten miles south of Dugway, UT. Chaparral, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and backing.

**Hawk**, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. Five miles north of Reno, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**McCully**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMENT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles northwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Little Giant**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMENT (CA Team 5). CIMENT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Sisi**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Active fire behavior with torching, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

**Paradise**, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMENT (SA Team 3). CIMENT (NW Team 8) mobilizing. CIMENT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Hagen**, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Austin**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMENT (GB Team 4). CIMENT is also managing the Grasshopper and the Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Grasshopper**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**The Narrows**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Sinlahekin**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMENT (SW Team 3). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Three Queens**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMENT (NR Team 2). CIMENT is also managing the King, Goat and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**King**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Goat**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Wonderland Complex**, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Wrights Spring**, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area closures in effect.

**Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires)**, Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Luna**, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

**Dudley**, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Five miles north of Wallace, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and torching. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area closures in effect.

**Sand Creek**, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1). CIMT is also managing the Bobcat Lakes, Moose and Skull incidents. Five miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Bobcat Lakes**, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Twelve miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Moose**, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Twenty-four miles southwest of Philipsburg, MT. Timber and heavy slash. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and smoldering. Residences threatened. Road and trail closures in effect.

**Skull**, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Wisdom, MT. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching.

**Nature Grove**, Bitterroot NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Hamilton, MT. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Deer Creek**, Northwestern Land Office, Montana DNRC. Eighteen miles west of Marion, MT. Heavy slash and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

**Silver**, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Eight miles northwest of Sandpoint, ID. Closed timber litter, timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Road and trail closures in effect.

**Upper Smith**, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Six miles west of Porthill, ID. Timber, medium slash and brush. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, flanking and backing. Road and trail closures in effect.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Hot temperatures will continue across the Plains today with highs near 100°F amid minimum RH of 15-25% and locally breezy south winds gusting to 20-25 mph. Tropical Storm Edouard will make landfall near the mouth of the Sabine River this evening bringing locally heavy rain to southeast Texas and far southwest Louisiana along with gusty winds. Scattered to widespread thunderstorms will also develop across much of Florida while a cold front moves through the Lower Great Lakes and Northeast with showers and thunderstorms. In the West, breezy and dry southwest winds will develop in much of western and southern Nevada into far northeast California and southeast Oregon creating elevated conditions as minimum relative humidity falls to 7-15%. Farther east, scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop in far northeast Oregon to central Idaho and southwest Montana then southward into the central Rockies, while isolated thunderstorms develop in the Southwest. Much cooler temperatures are expected west of the Cascades and Sierra today due to strong onshore flow.
