Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Santa Maria, CA. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with running, flanking and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

McConnell, Winnemucca District, BLM. CIMT (GB Team 6). Three miles east of Orovada, NV. Grass, dormant brush and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and uphill runs. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Blue Eagle, Carson City District, BLM. Twenty-eight miles northwest of Austin, NV. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened.

McCully, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). Twenty-two miles northwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and grass. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and the Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, single tree torching and spotting. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fourteen miles southwest of Dufur, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

The Narrows, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Fifteen miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Brush, grass and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 3) to CIMT (NW Team 8) will occur tomorrow. CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (SW Team 3). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, isolated torching and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT is also managing the King, Goat and Wonderland Complex incidents. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

King, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Goat, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Fifteen miles north of Ronald, WA. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and isolated torching. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 7) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and backing. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Electric, Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie NF, USFS. Seven miles north of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

*** Thunder Creek**, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirteen miles southeast of Newhalem, WA. Timber and dormant brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, heavy slash and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 5). CIMT is also managing the Sisi incident. Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. No new information.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, flanking and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Timber and brush. No new information.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Hot temperatures will continue across the Plains into the Lower and Middle Mississippi Valley today with highs near 100°F. Across the Southern Plains, RH is expected to lower to 15-25% with locally breezy south winds gusting to 20-25 mph. Tropical Storm Edouard will continue to track across southeastern Texas and weaken, bringing thunderstorms, locally heavy rain, and strong gusts to the area, with some areas on the periphery of the storm possibly experiencing thunderstorms and strong winds without much rainfall, increasing fire risk. Scattered to widespread thunderstorms will also develop across much of Florida as well as the Lower Great Lakes and Northeast. In the West, widespread breezy southwesterly winds develop along the Sierra Front, across the Great Basin, and into the West Slope, Wyoming, and western Montana, with particularly dry conditions across southern inland California and across Nevada, with minimum RHs of 5-20% are expected. Breezy conditions are also expected in the northwest into western Montana, however cooler weather with developing rain will moderate conditions. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are possible across the northern Great Basin into the Northern Rockies, mostly with wetting rain, however mixed wet/dry storms are possible across eastern Montana. Across the southwest and Four Corners, isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are possible.
