Two 15-member incident management teams and 212 fireline personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest and Great Basin geographic areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) and one from the 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard), with respective support personnel, have been deployed to Santa Maria, CA. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Little Giant fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Crooked, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Fifteen miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with running, flanking and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Grasshopper and The Narrows incidents. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Sisi, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Ten miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (SA Team 3) to CIMT (NW Team 8) will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wonderland Complex, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Twenty-one miles southeast of Buckley, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (SW Team 3). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and smoldering. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Hot temperatures continue across the Southern Plains and Mississippi Valley again today with highs reaching 100°F. Locally breezy winds pick up over Oklahoma and Kansas, although RH's will be up a bit, reaching 35-45%. Remnants of Edouard will produce another day of heavy rains across eastern Texas, while southern Texas will be dry and breezy.

Overall large fire potential continues to decrease over the Pacific Northwest, Northern California and western Idaho as showers with cooler temperatures spread across the area. Dry and breezy conditions are expected over much of the Great Basin up into Wyoming and eastern Montana. Showers and thunderstorms continue across southeast Arizona and begin to spread into western New Mexico.
