* **Bunker**, Arkansas Forestry Commission. Two miles east of East Camden, AR. Southern rough and timber. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, backing and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

* **Hydra**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Three miles south of Meridian, TX. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with long-range spotting, wind-driven runs and running. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

* **Dry River**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Five miles southeast of Sonora, TX. Grass. Extreme fire behavior with group torching, running and long-range spotting. Residences threatened.

* **Calvary Creek**, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles east of Rocky, OK. Grass and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and flanking.

* **Bundy**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Ten miles southeast of Telegraph, TX. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running and smoldering.

Gracemont, Anadarko Agency, BIA. Six miles east of Binger, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and crowning. Numerous structures threatened.

* **Atoka Lake**, Oklahoma DOF. Two miles northeast of Atoka, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing and creeping.

Tram Trail, Oklahoma DOF. Six miles northeast of Rattan, OK. Timber. Active fire behavior with creeping and backing. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Black Kettle, Oklahoma DOF. Four miles southeast of Roll, OK. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Hot temperatures will continue across the southern Plains today with highs near 100°F, with locally breezy southerly winds 12-20 mph and higher gusts amid minimum relative humidity of 15-25%, focused over central Texas. Hot temperatures will also spread northeastward into the Mid-Mississippi and Lower Ohio Valleys. Widespread showers and thunderstorms will develop in the Southwest and Four Corners today, with scattered showers and thunderstorms in Utah to western Colorado. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will develop with an upper-level low in northern California into southern Oregon and central Idaho, as well, while south winds 15-20 mph amid relative humidity of 10-15% develop across Nevada creating areas of elevated conditions. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will also develop along a weak front from the central Plains to the Lower Great Lakes. Isolated showers and thunderstorms will continue across Florida as well as the northern Gulf Coast.
