## IMSR Update (Maegan Maughan)

PL1, light IA, 62 new starts, 2 uncontained large fires, 5 crews, 16 engines, 2 helicopters, 239 personnel assigned.

**Southern Area:** PL2, 18 new starts, 1 uncontained large fire.

Matagorda South – Active behavior, grass, structures threatened, received precipitation, 500 acres, 30% contained.

**Southwest:** PL1, light IA.

Stanford – Minimal behavior, timber and grass, 306 acres, 60% contained.

## Predictive Services Update

### Weather Summary (Jim Wallmann)

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

##### Short-term (through Friday)

- Breezy dry for the northern Plains and Upper Midwest today and Thursday for locally elevated conditions
- Breezy/dry west winds bringing elevated conditions to the central High Plains tomorrow, with elevated to critical conditions possible again Thursday into the southern High Plains
- A drier pattern for much of the East, with periods of breezy west downslope winds for the east slopes of the central/southern Appalachians tomorrow and Thursday
- More active in the northern half of the West, with periods of precipitation, heaviest and most widespread Wednesday into Thursday
- A period of strong downslope winds Tuesday night and Wednesday for the Sierra Front creating elevated conditions

##### Long-term (Saturday through next Wednesday)

- The dry pattern continues for the Plains to the East Coast, with precipitation limited to the Great Lakes and Northeast
- Dry pre- and post-frontal winds will be a concern from the central/southern Plains to the Gulf Coast, Southeast, and Mid-Atlantic
- Drier for the West this weekend before more storms are likely to arrive mid-next week for the West Coast



### Fuels Summary (Steve Larrabee)

ERC percentiles nationwide are relatively low and mostly typical for this time of year.

Dry fuels are a concern in parts of the Upper Midwest and Western Great Lakes, where there are FWWs and RFWs in effect.

Areas in S Plains and TX are also drying, and that trend is expected to continue.
