## IMSR Update (Megan Kephart)

PL1, light IA, 415 new starts, 7 uncontained large fires, 944 personnel assigned.

**South Ops:** PL2, 66 new starts, 1 uncontained large fire.

Pack – Minimal behavior, brush and grass, structures threatened, evacuations, habitat threatened, 3,400 acres, 69% contained.

**Southern Area:** PL2, 233 new starts, 2 uncontained large fires, 1,200 resources assigned.

Bald Mountain – Moderate behavior, litter and slash, 4,300 acres, 71% contained.

Lignite – Minimal behavior, litter and slash, 180 acres, 95% contained.

## Predictive Services Update

### Weather Summary (Jim Wallmann)

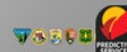
#### WEATHER SUMMARY

##### Short-term (through Friday)

- Breezy/dry west to northwest winds amid low RH from the east slopes of the Appalachians to the Piedmont today creating elevated to critical conditions and high-risk significant fire potential
- Tomorrow, breezy/dry southwest winds are expected in the southern Appalachians creating elevated conditions before conditions moderate with higher RH, lighter winds, and areas of precipitation Wednesday
- Breezy/dry west winds in the central/southern High Plains today creating elevated conditions today before wetting precipitation is expected Wednesday/Thursday, with heavy rainfall likely just to the east across central/eastern Oklahoma and Texas
- Continued wet in southern California into the Southwest this week, with mild and mostly dry conditions for the northern Intermountain West after today
- Moist trade winds in Hawai'i early this week with heavy rainfall possible for the Big Island

##### Long-term (Saturday through next Wednesday)

- Modest relief is expected to persist in the Appalachians to the Piedmont due to higher RH and lighter winds although wetting rainfall may be isolated
- Another round of rain for the southern Plains early next week, with wetting rain possible for the High Plains as well
- After a wet weekend, turning drier for southern California and the Southwest, with a possible return to cooler and wetter conditions for the northern half of the West mid-next week



### Fuels Summary (Steve Larrabee)

Reduction of Santa Ana wind event potential.

Exposed fuels in the Plains will provide potential for short term fires.

Water table levels in Florida are extremely dried up.

Drought continues to develop in the southeast.
