### Weather Summary (Jim Wallmann)

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

##### Short-term (through Friday)

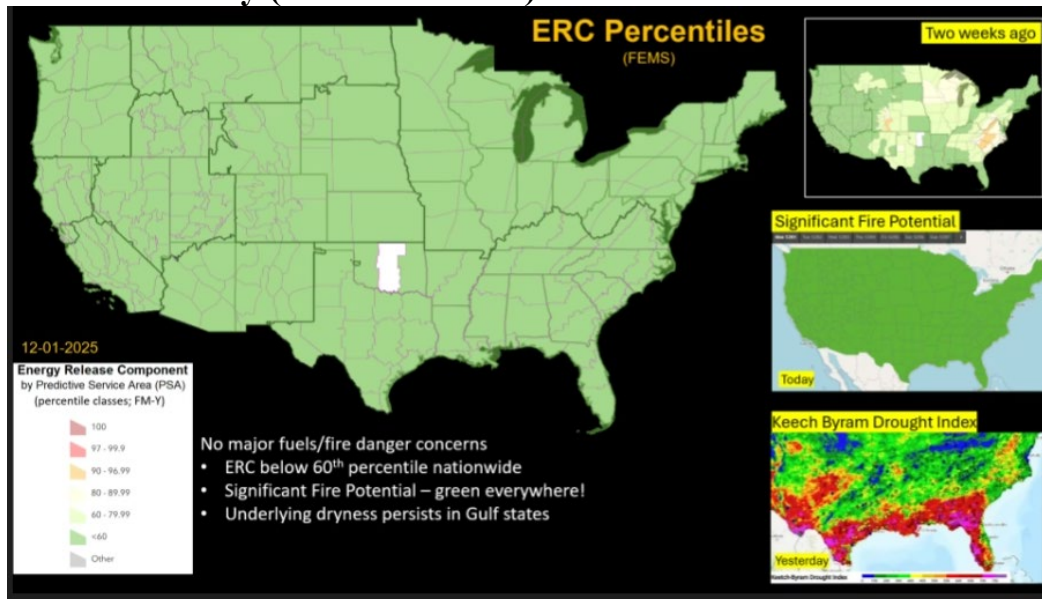
- Cold for the Intermountain West through midweek with snow for the Rockies, with light offshore winds possible mid to late week for California
- An atmospheric river will bring moderate precipitation and warming temperatures to the Northwest and northern Rockies late this week
- Periods of snow from the Mid-Mississippi Valley to the Great Lakes and Northeast, focused early and late week
- A wetter period is expected across the northern Gulf Coast, Lower Mississippi Valley, and Southeast this week, with widespread wetting rain early and late this week, but much of Florida will see little rain
- Snowy in western and Interior Alaska through midweek before turning much colder by the weekend

##### Long-term (Saturday through next Wednesday)

- Another atmospheric river will bring moderate to heavy precipitation to the Northwest and northern Rockies with high snow levels, but the southern half of the West is mild and dry
- Cold for much of the eastern US with a drier pattern, although periods of light snow are possible in the Great Lakes, Mid-Atlantic, and Northeast
- The greatest uncertainty lies near the Gulf Coast regarding additional precipitation, where periods of moderate rain is possible, but confidence is very low
