1. BLM Standards for Fire Training and Workforce Development

(Ellsworth)

Jeff and Mike presented the *BLM Standards for Fire Training and Workforce Development* to the Fire Operations Group (FOG) and received positive feedback. The comment period runs until December 7, 2012.

ACTION: Review the DRAFT BLM Standards for Fire Training and Workforce Development and forward comments to Mike Ellsworth by December 7, 2012. (All BFTC members)

2. FOG Issue Papers

(Ellsworth)

Leadership Training: Mike Ellsworth presented the BFTC's recommendation to make leadership required courses for certain fireline positions to the FOG at their November 2012 meeting. The proposal was well-accepted with one concern: lack of a requirement for RXB2. The RXB2 requirement will be added to the Fire Leadership Team (FLT) proposal for consideration at their December 2012 meeting in Grand Junction. If Jeff Arnberger cannot make the meeting, Kim Bang is requested to represent the BFTC.

Engine Captain: The FOG had a lengthy discussion regarding Engine Captain. They believe a solution is needed but could not come to consensus. Each course requirement was reviewed individually for possible inclusion in a BLM setID for ENGB. Mike will pull training statistics and work with Jeff to develop Red Book language for a possible solution to the problem.

ACTION: Collect training statistics for creating a BLM setID for ENGB, develop Red Book language, and present to the FOG on their December 2012 conference call. (Mike Ellsworth and Jeff Arnberger)

3. Geographic Training Area Representative (GATR) Update
