### AGENDA ITEMS:

#### 1. National Training Officer Role (Ellsworth)

Marlene Eno-Hendren is assimilating into her position in Fire Operations. Marlene and Mike Ellsworth are working to establish roles and responsibilities. Marlene will assume the co-chair position of the BFTC; handle BLM-specific training matters, including co-chairing the BFTC; and working with IFPM and NIJAC. Mike Ellsworth will work on interagency matters such as OTC, IQCS, WFSTAR, and leadership.

#### 2. FOG/FLT Update (Ellsworth)

##### Type 1 C and G State-Level Certification

The FLT recently endorsed the BFTC's recommendation to add a minimum standard to the Red Book requiring Type 1 Command and General Staff and Area Command be certified by State FMOs (or the Chief of Fire Operations for NIFC & WO staff). The standard will be added to the 2016 *BLM Standards for Fire Training and Workforce Development*.

##### Dozer Operator

The FOG accepted adoption of the USFWS position task book for DZOP/DZIA. Additionally, the tractor/plow operator qualification will reflect the same qualification standards as DZOP/DZIA. Employees with that qualification will be grandfathered in.

Non-fire Mandatory Training

Steve Shaw and Paul Hohn briefed the FLT on the non-fire mandatory training issue and will develop a paper for Ron Dunton to present to the ELT.

Chainsaw Refresher

The BFTC continues to seek feedback regarding chainsaw refresher. All feedback must be received by **May 1, 2015**.

- a. Should the BLM require a chainsaw refresher? Why?
- b. What would you recommend the required refresher time-frames be, e.g., annual or biennial? Should the same frequency be for all Faller positions?
- c. Considering bureauwide implications, what objectives would you like to see as the national standard in the BLM chainsaw refresher?
