Predictive Services Discussion:

Dry and breezy conditions will continue today across southern New Mexico with continued moderate significant fire potential. Breezy and dry west winds are likely to develop across portions of Virginia and North Carolina as well. Upper low pressure will move through the Northeast with scattered to widespread thunderstorms, while Wisconsin and Michigan are drier today. Isolated to scattered showers will develop from the eastern Sierra through the central Great Basin and into much of the Rockies. Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms will develop across the Deep South to the Georgia coast, with several severe thunderstorms likely. A heat wave will begin to build across south Texas with high temperatures over 100°F forecast this afternoon.
