

NIFC WIRELESS NETWORK – DOI EMPLOYEE Instructions

ALL DEVICES

These instructions are intended for **DOI Employees** that would like to use the **NIFC Guest Wireless Network**. This connection does not provide access to Agency internal networks. Minor variations from these instructions may occur depending on the device and its software version.

Step 1: Connect your device to the NIFC Guest Wi-Fi network.

Step 2: Open your Internet browser. If it does not automatically redirect to the NIFC Wi-Fi page, try to go to a public website such as <http://www.google.com>. The browser will then redirect to the NIFC Wi-Fi page.

Step 3: Click on the link that says “Click Here to login with DOI credentials” at the bottom of the page.

Step 4: Login with your DOI Active Directory credentials using the following format. NOTE: Not all DOI Active Directory credentials are identical to your email address. Please use the following examples to determine the format that works for your agency. Contact the NIFC Help Desk if you need assistance:

jwayne@nps.gov (not john_wayne@nps.gov)
john.wayne@indianaffairs.gov (not @bia.gov)
jwayne@usbr.gov
jwayne@ios.doi.gov
john_wayne@fws.gov

Accept the terms of use and click Log In
Your device will now be connected to NIFC Guest.
